

Subject: Volunteer Opportunity: Steering Committee for Community Center Planning

Dear Community Members,

At last night's meeting, the Eagle Board of Trustees adopted Resolution No. 2026-02 which will submit to the registered voters residing in the corporate limits of Eagle the question of increasing the local sales and use tax from one percent (1%) to one and one-half percent (1.5%) at the Statewide Primary Election set for May 12, 2026. The additional one-half percent (0.5%) will specifically be used for the necessary expenses to renovate the existing fire station into a Community Center and for one-third ( $\frac{1}{3}$ ) of the construction costs of the new Fire & Rescue Station.

The Village of Eagle is excited to announce an initiative to develop plans for a Community Center and is seeking dedicated volunteers to form a Steering Committee to lead this effort.

The purpose of this committee is to:

- Assist with public education efforts on the proposed sales tax increase.
- Guide the initial planning and vision for the Community Center.
- Gather community input on needs, features, and design preferences.
- Work with Village staff to develop a preliminary proposal and framework for the project.

We are looking for individuals with a strong interest in the future of our community who can commit to attending meetings (dates/times TBD) and actively participating in the planning process.
